- English: -

 4. Learn minimum 20 word meanings given in your English reference book daily.
 5. Revise all grammar topics already taught to you.
 6. Make a diary entry everyday (in minimum 100 words) before going to bed.
 7. Make a poster on Covid-19 making people aware about the seriousness of it.
 8. Prepare a notice informing the people about the meeting that you want to convene because you want to tell them the meaning of social distancing.
- Maths:-
1. Learn and write tables 2 to 40.
 2. Learn and write square numbers 20 to 30.
 3. Learn and write cube numbers 2 to 20.
- Economics:- Revise the topics which more relevant to class XII.
