Schools at a Glance

Both Schools are English Medium, Sr. Sec., Co-Educational, Residential-Cum-Day Schools, affiliated to CBSE, ISO certified institutions. These schools are managed by Dundlod Shikshan Sansthan, Dundlod.



GEOGRAPHICAL LOCATION

Dundlod school campus sprawls over 18 acres of land. The school is located on the top of Dundlod Sand Hill Station in Shekhawati Region on the Jaipur-Pilani Road near Nawalgarh in Jhunjhunu district in Rajasthan. Dundlod, the heritage place, is connected to various parts of the country by roads and by railways. It is 2.5 hours journey from Jaipur, 1 hour from Pilani & 5 hours from Delhi. The nearest airport is Sanganer, Jaipur.



GEOGRAPHICAL LOCATION



The imposing building of the Jhunjhunu school is located at Mandawa Road, Sitsar, Jhunjhunu in an open and pollution free area well equipped with sandpit, swings, aquariums, gardens & lawns. The school is easily accessible as it is next to the city railway station and bus stand. It is 3 hours journey from Jaipur, half an hour from Pilani & 4.5 hours from Delhi. The nearest airport is Sanganer, Jaipur.

AIMS & OBJECTIVES :

The schools are dedicated to prepare conscientious and responsible citizens with a sense of integrity and rectitude who will be imbued with a spirit of adventure, exploration, research and creation. The schools aim at imparting meaningful education and help the students in developing scientific temper, modern outlook and love for the motherland, its culture, heritage and traditions. The medium of instruction, right from the beginning, is English. English and Hindi languages are taught from Pre-Primary classes. Third language, Sanskrit, is taught from class 6th onwards.



CURRICULAR STRUCTURE OF SCHOOL

Presently the schools are running classes as per new pedagogical structure and curricular of school education which is as follows:

- (A) Foundational Stage – Classes Nursery to II
- (B) Preparatory Stage – Classes III to V
- (C) Middle Stage – Classes VI to VIII
- (D) Secondary Stage – Classes IX to XII

Even, the schools have two vocational courses after class X which are as follows:

- (I) Financial Marketing Management (FMM)
- (II) Healthcare Sciences



A – Foundational Stage

The foundational stage consists of five classes viz Nursery to II where 3+ is age criterion for nursery and so on and so forth. This division of TINY TOTS is placed under the responsibility and able guidance of competent and specially trained teachers to ensure effective functioning. The children are nurtured like the delicate flowers. The method of teaching includes Play-way, Kindergarten, Montessori, Gandhiji's Moral Teachings and Activity Based Learning. The children are encouraged to develop an all round personality through singing, dancing, painting, reading, writing and exploring the environment. A spacious playground, park, mini-aquarium, toys library and the audio-visual teaching aids are set up to keep the children in good humour and to attract their attention and to make them more curious and attentive. Our teaching environment is based on love, affection and motherly touch. The focus is on the reinforcement and endorsement of a child capability through manifold activities and learning exercises.

B – Preparatory Stage

Preparatory stage classes include III to V. Apart from the major subjects like English, Hindi, Maths, General Science & Social Studies, emphasis is given on Computer Science, Health & Physical Education, Art & Craft, Music & Dance, G.K. and Value Education also. Needless to say both the schools want to cultivate discipline, manners & etiquettes in students. Efforts are made to enrich the vocabulary and equip them with communicative



competence. The building that houses preparatory stage classes has its own library, computer lab, maths lab and an audio-visual resource centre, all having the latest and modern equipments and devices.

C – Middle Stage

Middle stage comprises classes VI to VIII which has continuous and comprehensive evaluation system. The compulsory subjects are English, Hindi, Maths, General Science, Social Science, Sanskrit, Information Technology and graded subjects are Health & Physical Education, Art & Craft, Music, Yoga and G.K & Value Education. In the new era of globalized modern education, competition is tough for every exam. Hence, the need arises for an early beginning and clear insight about one's future plans. Thus our devoted teachers make the students more responsible and career conscious at an early stage of life, the strong concept building starts from the class VI onwards.



D – Secondary Stage

Secondary stage covers classes IX to XII. This section strives hard to satisfy inquisitiveness of the students and prepares the students to meet the challenges of life and march ahead with confidence. Furthermore, it equips them with a passion for excellence and determination to meet the future challenge. Students can pursue their class XI onwards studies as per the three streams offered by school i.e., Science, Commerce and Arts.

01. Subjects of Science Stream:

English Core, Physics, Chemistry are compulsory. Mathematics, Biology, Computer Science, Informatics Practices, Biotechnology & Physical Education are offered as optional subjects.



02. Subjects of Commerce Stream:

English Core, Accountancy, Business Studies are compulsory. Economics, Informatics Practices, Computer Science, Mathematics & Physical Education are offered as optional subjects.

03. Subjects of Arts Stream:

English Core, History, Political Science are compulsory and Geography, Economics, Mathematics, Sociology, Physical Education & Informatics Practices are offered as optional subjects.



Job Oriented Vocational Courses:

1. **FINANCIAL MARKETING MANAGEMENT (FMM):** This course helps students get employment in Financial Markets, Banking & Insurance Sectors, Commodity Market, BPOs & Call Centres. One can continue higher studies as well after passing +2 as the course has been recognised for the admission to various under graduate courses by different universities.

SALIENT FEATURES :

1. In each classroom, close circuit camera is installed to watch classroom activities.
2. Most modern & innovative methods of teaching.
3. Use of Audio-Visual teaching aids like tape recorder, overhead projectors, slide projector, computer, mini-theatre etc. is emphasized at a large extent.
4. Well equipped science labs (Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Biotechnology & Maths) and an ultra modern computer lab with broadband facility.
5. A spacious and centrally-air-cooled hostel for boys at Dundlod.
6. Teacher student ratio is 1:25.
7. Meaningful personality development classes are run.
8. Teachers are from all over the country who are highly qualified, dedicated, innovative & committed to their profession. Mandatory workshops and seminars on teaching methodology are conducted to keep the teachers abreast of latest teaching techniques.
9. The Computerised library contains around 5000 volumes of books and encyclopedia and a large number of Indian and Foreign magazines and journals.
10. A well planned wing for pre-primary section has been constructed with beautiful garden, toy house, mini-fish-aquarium, audio-visual room and music room.
11. Well qualified instructors provide regular coaching to students in athletics, table tennis, lawn tennis, basketball, badminton, football, volleyball, hockey, cricket, boxing, judo karate, taekwondo, gymnastics, horse riding & swimming.
12. Language lab well equipped with lingua phones and audio visual aids, facilitates the development of good communication skills and teach students correct pronunciation and diction.
13. Adopting smart class is another milestone that schools can boast of. This is a big leap forward where the complex becomes simple & fascinating, it illuminates abstract & difficult concepts with liquid clarity bridges learning gaps and helps both teachers and students realise their true potential. These classes have been running smoothly for the last three years.
14. Imposing and colossal school auditorium that can seat over two thousand audience.
15. Indoor sports complex to satisfy the taste of those students who want to take an early call in games and sports.

CO-SCHOLASTIC ACTIVITIES/AREAS

To have all round development of a child, the schools provide tremendous opportunities to each individual child to show his/her profound talent in the games & sports, cultural & literary activities.

1. Health & Physical Education: The scheme of physical education is so planned as to ensure the maximum and manifold development of the individuality of the child, enabling him/her to attain mental soundness, emotional stability, physical maturity and moral values. Games and sports are organized in such a way as to ensure maximum participation by students at the same time. Well-qualified instructors provide regular coaching to students in athletics, judo, taekwondo, gymnastics, yoga, skating, swimming and horse riding.



2. Cultural & Literary Activities: Cultural & literary activities develop the aesthetic beauty in the personality of the students. schools provide profound opportunities to each individual child to come up on the stage through their various cultural and literary activities like debate, dramatics, elocution, extempore speech, western & indian solo and group song and dance, western instrumental music etc. The students display their cultural & literary taste on annual function apart from CCAs on every Saturday.



A. Music Department: All sorts of instruments like harmonium, tabla, dholak, guitar, synthesizer, casio, bass drum, side drum and melodica adorn the music room. Adept instructors from music rich states have been appointed to impart music education.



B. Art & Craft Department: As part of the art education, students study commercial art, painting, models, sculpture etc.

C. Clubs: School offers different clubs to provide an opportunity for adaptation to life in the group. Students learn to cope with life situations at an early age; they learn good life long habits and cultivate a sense of willing helpers or volunteers. They become a good and productive asset for the nation. Club activities supplement academics and give the students practical training which will come in handy at a later stage.



3. C.C.A: Every Saturday in the last 2 periods, all the students of Red, Blue, Yellow and Green houses assemble in the school auditorium and show their variety of talent. 1st, 2nd & 3rd rankers of these competitions are felicitated every Monday in school morning assembly.

4. Embracing NEP 2020 : Keeping abreast of the changing times and to embrace NEP 2020, the school has introduced some best practices to provide students some digital platform in that some students learn better when exposed to all type of intelligence.

(A) Step & Learn : Step and Learn is an interactive floor especially targeted at children from 3 to 12 years of age. It promotes collective and differentiated learning styles through play and physical activity. It satisfies the concept of 'Multiple Intelligence' and increases personal, social and professional skills.

(B) Cubetto : Cubetto is a wooden robot designed to teach children how to code using a tangible programming language that doesn't use screens or require children to be that much technologically strong.

C) Science Virtual Lab : Science virtual lab is an advanced lab designed to provide a digital platform for conducting a variety of interactive science experiments for grades 6 to 10. It commits to providing a superlative hands-on experience in a virtual environment with main emphasis on "Learning by Doing".

(D) Robotics Lab: Robotics Lab is an easy to understand, hands-on educational platform where students learn by doing. Robotics Lab teaches one coding literacy without the need for a tech guru for guidance. It's a cloud-based program that operates through browser software.

5. Educational Tour: To give first hand knowledge to the students, schools manage different types of tours.

(a) Short Tour: Near about 10 short tours in a year to railway station, hospitals, banks, post offices, BSNL, press, museum, doordarshan kendra etc. are arranged for the students to see the practical working in these organizations to meet the real pragmatic challenges of life.



(b) One Day Tour: One day tour is arranged for the students to be face-to-face with the nature to learn & appreciate the natural beauty to develop their aesthetic quality.

C) Long Tour: It is mainly arranged during Dussehra vacation to some other state to gain the knowledge of local topography and also understand the tradition & culture of the people of that particular place.

EXAMINATION & PROMOTION :

Schools have a system of continuous & comprehensive evaluation. There are weekly tests, unit tests, term exams, periodical tests and final exams. The promotion to the next class depends on the cumulative academic achievements of the students at the end of the academic session.

RESIDENTIAL SYSTEM :

A. Hostel : There are two hostel blocks for boys in the school premises. The first one is for classes I to V and second one is for classes VI to XII. Hostel is centrally air-cooled and spacious. It has been designed meticulously to fulfil the challenging requirements of the children of all age groups. It includes separate dormitories for junior students and rooms for senior students. The junior dormitories are adequately spacious with attached wash rooms, changing rooms and toilets. Each child is provided with separate bed, study table, almirah etc. Osmosis Water Purification System with water cooler has also been made available.



B. Mess: Most hygienic mess, situated in the campus, serves pure wholesome food. Four meals a day include breakfast with milk, lunch, evening snacks with milk, dinner and night milk. We feel proud in serving 100% organic food. Vegetables, pulses and wheat are organically grown and are free from pesticides and chemicals.



C. Games & Gymnastics: The hostel is equipped with the modern facilities for games & gymnastics because it is well known fact that "sound mind dwells in sound body" hence more emphasis has been given on body building by doing regular exercises in gym or yoga or playing different games. Students enjoy themselves with table-tennis, carrom, chess, badminton, basketball, cricket, football, volleyball & horse riding.



D. Adventure Sports: Horse riding, skating and rock climbing are regular features for the hostel students.

E. Evening & Night Classes: All the boarders have been divided class wise for evening and night classes and all the necessary subjects are taught. One special group has been kept for weak students. All these students are taught separately by residential teachers for two and half hours daily in the evening class and finally homework & self study is done under supervision of the residential teachers in night classes.



F. Recreation: The students watch TV news to keep themselves updated and to know what is happening in the world around them. They also enjoy comedy serials for light recreation for a limited time. Students are motivated to watch some message giving serials or movies on Saturday night. Every Sunday night brings an opportunity for boarders to exhibit their co-curricular talent.

IMPORTANT GUIDELINES:

1. Prospectus & admission form can be obtained from school office during school hours.
2. For Provisional admission in class XI, a candidate must submit class IX Report Card along with a xerox of class X pre- board exam report card.
3. There is no direct admission to classes X & XII. Admission can be given only in transfer case of parents or shifting of house with documental proof.
4. Schools strictly follow all the rules & regulations of RTE Act.



Documents to be produced at the time of Admission:

1. For class up to 1st original birth certificate along with self attested photocopy of the same.
2. For class II and above, original T.C. countersigned by the competent authority and report card of previous academic session.
3. Three passport size photographs.
4. Migration certificate for the student coming from other board / state.
5. **The procedure for admission for overseas and foreign applicants at DPS remains the same. However foreign passport holders are required to obtain a student's Visa from the Indian Embassy/Consulate in their country. They can apply for the Visa once their application for admission has been approved by the school's Admissions Committee and a letter confirming admission is issued to the applicant. The Visa obtained must be for the tenure that the student studies at the school.**

FEE RULES:

- (i) Tuition fee and boarding fee is payable in two equal instalments in the month of April and October. It must be paid in the first week of due month.
- (ii) All payments should be made by cheque/ digital transactions/ payment gateway/ RTGS/NEFT.
- (iii) Fee once deposited will not be refunded under any circumstances.
- (iv) Transfer Certificate is issued only after all the dues are settled.
